I, the member and user of Peldon Cricket, agree to the following Terms & Conditions:

To accept all responsibility for assessing the suitability of the facility for myself or my child or any person under 18 that I am responsible for. The individual accepts that the flooring, lighting, netting and other characteristics of the facility are acceptable for themselves, their dependant or their child;

To accept full responsibility for injuries or death to either myself, my dependant or my child while using the facility. To accept responsibility for all safety aspects prior to, during or subsequent to the use of the facility and I, the member must accept liability for any loss, damage, injury or death, howsoever or by whomever caused, whether to property or persons sustained by any person in the facility;

To supply to Peldon Cricket an up-to-date liability insurance as a club in order to cover all individuals training under a club made booking;

To not exceed 8 persons in total per lane;

To wear and protect myself with the appropriate protective equipment such as helmets, leg pads, thigh guards, groin protectors, gloves, arm guards etc;

To not use the bowling machine irresponsibly;

To not use the bowling machine if I am not confident of how to do so;

To not be intoxicated while using the facility;

To report any issues, problems, litter, spillages, trespassing, damage to equipment or damage to the property to the business owner via the email address provided as soon as possible (info@peldoncricket.co.uk);

To pay in full before I attend my time slot;

To not make any temporary or permanent alterations to the building or equipment including bowling machines, stumps, nets, flooring, lights etc;

To not remove any of Peldon Cricket's property or equipment from the facility;

To not use the facility if I am aware or have any knowledge as to any possible serious health conditions or pre existing injuries that may limit my safety if alone;

To not leave litter or rubbish on the site;

To not leave any residual food or liquids in the facility unless in a waste bin;

To accept and acknowledge the facility is located on an active and working farm and to take responsibility for my or my party's safety;

To accept full responsibility for any injuries caused by me or inflicted on to me by another user;

To not use the facility unless it has been paid for and it has been booked through the website;

To not use the facility if I have any knowledge of any diseases or contractable viruses/infections I or somebody in my household may have;

To use the facility solely for the purpose of cricket training;

To not use any bicycles, scooters, skateboards or such like, motorbikes or mechanically propelled devices in the facility, such as a drone;

To accept responsibility for the safe entry and exit of the facility when considering other users that may be using the field before or after me;

To finish my time slot and be ready to leave on time;

To allow enough time to exit the facility before interfering with the next user;

To arrive at a reasonable time before or within the allocated time slot;

To ensure all doors are closed on entry and exit;

To use just the facility provided and no other piece of land or building in the close vicinity;

To leave my vehicle and its contents, during my time slot, entirely at my own risk. The vehicle and its contents are my own responsibility and will not be parked there longer than the booked time slot. (Parking is free). I will notify Peldon Cricket if there is an issue with my vehicle, and it cannot be moved;

To leave enough of an access for vehicular movements in and out of the site;

To park away from the road and next to the entrance;

To leave my valuables, training equipment and personal belongings inside or outside of the facility, during my time slot, entirely at my own risk.

To be 18 years old or over. If you are under 18, you must be accompanied by an adult (person of 18 years or older);

To accept that I may be contacted by Peldon Cricket with the phone number or email address provided;

Peldon Cricket will not knowingly share your personal information with any third parties;

Peldon Cricket accept no responsibility for any injuries, ailments or death sustained to the user;

Peldon Cricket also accepts no responsibility for any damage to or theft of personal belongings, materials or equipment.

The owners of Peldon Cricket retain the right to terminate any membership at their discretion or if any of these Terms & Conditions are breached.
